Progress update:

- The final count on the public survey responses was 412. Work on the analysis and presentation of the data continues. The initial results can be seen at the open evening on Tuesday 22nd March.
- We have initiated a study for establishing Design Codes for buildings in any new developments. This will help to determine what new buildings should look like and the standards to be applied. For this work we will also need to complete a characterisation study of the different areas of the Parish.
