2016-07-8 Reports	<p>PT & HR attended Network Rail meeting at Patchway School Community College. Also present were Mike/Jeanette Fish. (Report by PT)</p> <p>A pretty poor event, with an intermittent sound system, but at least we got an answer to a question that has been a rumour for some time...</p> <p>As the various people said their piece I noticed that nothing had been said about Pilning Station. Throughout the presentations they kept saying that they wouldn't take questions, and that we could ask our individual questions of their reps at the back after.</p> <p>At the end I raised my hand and suggested that some of the questions were general that we all wanted to hear, and pointed out that they had not said what was happening to Pilning Station footbridge.</p> <p>The Network Rail rep then said, in the public, that the bridge is to be removed and not to be replaced. He further said that there had been a consultation about it. He then went on to say that there had been plans to build lots of houses at Pilning but that had now been dropped, so there wasn't the justification that there would be more passengers coming from that development.</p> <p>To answer Heather's point about how will she cross the track on her return journey, he said that she will have to stay on the train, go to the next station, get off there, cross the bridge(which is being replaced) and catch a train coming in the opposite direction.</p> <p>To a further question(others were getting far more animated than us), the Rep said that he couldn't justify the expense of a replacement bridge. I responded to that to say that he may well be right with his conclusion, but that a proper process of consultation was necessary before such a conclusion could be reached, as far as I was aware, there had been no consultation about the removal of the footbridge with the Parish Council. I also said that there had been no proposal for a development of housing at Pilning..</p> <p>There was an officer from South Glos there, who confirmed that no consultation with SG Councillors had been conducted. I shall cc this to Robert, perhaps he could advise.?</p> <p>Whilst we welcome the improvements to the railways, and we may have to accept a further deterioration in the service to Pilning, frankly, the representatives of the people appear to have been sidelined, I wonder even if Jack LoPresti knew?</p> <p>At the end, Jeanette Fish and HR questioned one of the reps about Jon King's plaque on the station bridge. We were told it could be put on a wall somewhere.</p> <p>Jeanette enquired about any fencing off that may be done to the bank behind Wainbridge Crescent.
