<u>Hemlock Water Dropwort</u> – reports have been received that this invasive plant has been seen on watercourses in the Severnside area. It is like cow parsley but the flower heads are more domed. It is the most poisonous plant in this country – ingesting even a small amount causes seizures and sudden death.

<u>Martyn's Law</u> – Anti terror law. Information from SLCC and others. This new law will have implications for both Village Halls and other public buildings and spaces in the Parish. Duty holders will be required to undertake simple, yet effective activities to improve protective security and preparedness.

# Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group (NPSG) Report to Parish Council 3rd July 2023 – delivered by Richard Edwards

NPSG meeting since last PC meeting was on 13th June. Matters discussed and arising since as follows:

Steering Group Membership:

Robert Goard has taken on the role of Secretary, and we are pleased to receive an application from Gill Cox to join the Steering Group, formally at our next meeting.

# Funding:

Despite now being more than 3 months into this financial year, government funding for 2023-24 for the Neighbourhood Planning Support Programme is still not available. This now presents a risk to our progress.

#### **Evaluation of Sites:**

The Steering Group has continued with its own evaluation of sites for availability, having meetings with landowners and/or their agents. There are a few sites where despite our efforts, landowners have been unwilling to engage with us. We have therefore concluded, for the time being, these sites are not available and not to be taken forward in the plan.

#### Meeting with SGC

We have a meeting arranged on the 6<sup>th</sup> July with the Strategic Planning Team of SGC. We will discuss with them land and assets where they are stakeholders. We have informed them of the sites that are identified as available and considered most suitable for various uses. We hope to agree with them, the appropriate strategy for addressing issues such as flooding and green belt.
