Dedicated volunteers are required to join this group and increase local road safety together with the new Lorrywatch, which is also being actioned. Help make our 'B' roads safer and HGV free.

Foxes – In our area, we have rural and now urban foxes. These have become very popular in town as the waste food

in unfastened bins, particularly junk food is easier to obtain than their normal prey of rabbits etc. To keep this situation under control, please ensure your waste food bins are always securely fastened. This is a perfectly normal environment for these animals to live.

The Wave – This has been announced in the Press but no local consultation has taken place. Sheila Cook is rectifying this situation and an article, which will be published in 'InView' and the 'Lych Gate' in August. The Wave Park proposal is at a very early stage. No offer has been made for the land. No financial package has been agreed. No planning application had been submitted, possibly September is proposed. When an application is eventually submitted, concerns about the effects on Green Belt, highway network, drainage etc will have to be addressed by the applicant and a consultation process for residents will be part of this Planning Application. The proposed entrance will be Washingpool Farm, Easter Compton. I am aware the Highway Authorities already share our concern for traffic on Blackhorse Hill in the post ECOZoo scenario.

Sheila Cook has help write an article for next week's Evening Post to clarify the position. An exhibition is planned in July at the 'Halls', Easter Compton.
