To discuss the commemorations of the end of World War I Discussion was held with suggestions of ringing the Church Bells, lighting a beacon, planting trees and or poppies and attending the Church service. It was agreed that a working group would be formed to make the arrangements with volunteers being FCAB, SCB, MP & CW.</p> <p>2. To agree the support of FoSBR work in relation to Pilning Station The following statement was agreed by all- ‘Pilning and Severn Beach Parish Council support FOSBR and the Pilning Rail Group in their campaign to restore the Pilning footbridge. While we value the rail service at Severn Beach station, we note that over the past six months the service has been highly unsatisfactory due to the problems associated with the introduction of the new Class 166 Turbos. We also recognise that Pilning is directly connected to Wales and close to Cribbs Causeway and much nearer to Thornbury than Severn Beach. We therefore consider that an hourly service to Pilning would be very well patronised and therefore welcome and support the campaign by FOSBR and others for its restoration.’</p> <p>3. Local Major Developments FCAB updated the meeting that the four warehouses being built on the former ICI land will have a new access onto the A403. KW noted the new cyclepath on the A403 will need to be redone when the new junction is in position.</p> <p>4.
