Notice is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended intends to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles, foot passengers, pedal cycles and equestrians that length of Station Road which extends from a point 240 metres north east of its junction with Shaymoor Lane in a north easterly direction for a distance of 75 metres.
