- 452. Reduction in bus fares to Old Aged Pensioners.

  Mr. Kelly, the R.D. Clerk to the Council advises that this matter is to be considered by the Council in due course, and the result will be held in abeyance until information is forthcoming.
- 463. Application to Develops at Severn Beach.

  This concerned the erection of building to be used as a store and occasional maintenance depot at the rear of Osborne Road, Severn Beach. It was decided to raise no objection to the application.
- 464. Application to Develope at Pilning.

  Land between Ellinghurst and Cranmoor Bridges.

  Some descussion on this metter took place and the Councillors were desirous of knowing what light industry would be occupying the site, and if local people would find employment should the application be granted, failing this Councillors would be against the project.
- 444. Cross Hands Rail Bridge.

  The Railway Engineers attention is to be drawn to the slipping of the embankment leading to the railway bridge at Cross Hands and the danger to pedestrians, and to the Church footpath where it crosses the disused railway.
- 217. 30 M.P.H. Speed Limit, Ableton Lane.

  Mr. Andain informed the Council he had placed this matter in the hands of the County Surveyor and his decision is to be awaited.
- 381. Fouling of Footpaths by Dogs. A set of posters for distribution in the parish has been received, these show it is an offence to County Bye-law to allow a dog to foul a footway of any street or public place.
