ORN 19 AT SEVERN BEACH) DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION

The above Order made on 27 March 2024, has been confirmed by South Gloucestershire Council.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding to them a footpath commencing at the boundary of the south east corner of the Severn Beach recreation ground, **Point A** on the order plan (grid reference ST 5438 8471), and running in a south-southeasterly direction across a field, parallel to the western boundary hedge, for a distance of 102 metres to where it meets public footpaths ORN 51 and ORN 19, **Point B** on the order plan (grid reference ST 5440 8461), east of the footbridge which exits the field into land at School Way. Shown as a bold broken line marked **A – B** on the map contained in this order. The width of the path is 2 metres throughout its length. The total length is 102 metres. The number of the footpath to be added is **ORN 82**.

The order became operative on 12 June 2024 and a copy of the order, as confirmed, and the order map may be seen free of charge at Patchway One Stop Shop, The Patchway Hub, Rodway Road, Patchway during normal opening hours. Any person aggrieved by the order who desires to question the validity of, or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, or on the grounds that any of the relevant requirements of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, may within six weeks of the date of this Notice, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
