News for Pilning, Severn Beach, Easter Compton & Hallen. March 2022

Dear Ward Members,

Ukraine – This invasion has caused many hardships to it's populous. South Glos. Council has offered to help and I send my thoughts and prayers too.

Algae – has been reported in the ponds in Western Approaches. South Glos. are checking the toxicity out.

Severnside Master Plan - I attended the first meeting of this group and await developments. A future lifestyles report was also presented.

Oldbury proposed Fusion reactor – I attended the presentation on this new power station. **Clifton Zoo** – is closing in September. The more precise date will be published later. Some animals are being dispersed to other zoo parks. The Wild Place will concentrate on breeding endangered species. South Glos. are reviewing the future traffic plans.

Postage Stamps – are going up on 4th April. Since Covid the post has reduced by 20%.

Rejected emails – these are being rejected by the South Glos. filter screen.

Planning Activity – currently all applications are taking longer than before the pandemic.

5–12-year-olds – can have a reduced Pfizer vaccination if their parents agree. Clinics will run through the half term.

Storm Eunice – this seemed to pass by with little ill effects. The new seawall seemed to be fit for purpose and the Streetcare sandbags lorry was not required.

Only debris, flotsam and jetsam need clearing from the foreshore. We were surprised our solar panels were producing hot water and electricity in the storm. I was told low flying trampolines proved to be a road hazard!

Brabazon Development – I was a member of the District Councillors trip around this venture and the Arena complex. The houses are state of the art 'E' standard and some are being lived in. Solar Panels and car charging sockets are standard together with current insulation standards. We were told there is a waiting list. The Filton West station upgrade is planned for 2023 with a Metrobus stop.
