Public Survey

A big thank you to everyone who completed their Neighbourhood Plan survey which went out on time on 17th November and closed on 20th December.

Next month we'll be able to give you the response rate, which at the time of going to print was very positive.

Our work on analysing the results will now begin, but will take some time and will involve some professional guidance and oversight.

The results will be published and presented for discussion in public forums at various locations in the Parish. You will be informed by email if you've registered with us, otherwise please look out for these In View newsletters.

The outcome of the survey will assist us in formulating our next steps and shaping the future direction of our Neighbourhood Plan.

Progress update:

• Following our comments, the Housing Needs Assessment Report has been finalised and now recognises an additional need for accommodation for the elderly in the Parish. It proposes an indicative figure of 30 to 41 specialist units being required during the plan period to 2035.

• The survey was produced and delivered efficiently and economically, coming in well under budget. We're now looking at how some our grant funding may be re-directed.

• The survey identified some misunderstandings of the current Green Belt, so we've added a map to our website

• We are now commencing our work on the survey of businesses, organisations and groups within the Parish. We will need help. If you want to get involved or wish to be a point of contact for any of these, activities please let us know.
