#### APPENDIX C - REPORT FROM SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL (ROBERT GRIFFIN)

News for Pilning & Severn Beach.

1<sup>st</sup> April 2013

Dear Ward Members,

South Glos. Council Tax - Will be frozen again this year. 2013/14

<u>Part Night Street lighting</u> - During April 2013, some streetlights in Pilning, Severn Beach and Almondsbury are programmed to be converted to operate on a part night basis.

<u>Lower Severn Inland Drainage Board</u> – Some submissions already received on Swanmoor and Bilsham lane rhines flooding, have been passed to the Lower Severn Internal Drainage Board, a reply received and forwarded.

<u>Wessex Water</u> – I requested Wessex Water to install a relief foul water sewage pipe from the Swanmoor Pumping Station to Avonmouth via the Industrial Estate. This was to avoid the unpleasant overloading at Swanmoor during periods of heavy rain. No answer received.

<u>Bilsham Lane ditches</u> – These are the responsibility of the adjoining landowners. Please could they be cleared for the good of all?

<u>Travellers</u> – An illegal travellers' site with 30 caravans was in the Sevalco car park just over the Bristol border and 6 extra in our Bank Road site at Pilning. Within 1 mile of these 30 caravans Bristol Council have built a new travellers site with all services. These were evicted from Sevalco within a few days but left behind their piles of rubbish. They headed down the A403.

<u>Abandoned Horses</u> – 57 now checked OK. One dead foal removed. Patchway based travellers are using the foreshore for fly grazing. Some horses have been moved from the foreshore to Western Approaches. 3 separate incidents of these horses getting onto the motorway at junction 18, PRP Rescue Services Ltd recovered them. Also getting onto the A403 and causing problems for the Police to deal with. A Statement from Jamie Shiels PC 3309: Today I have assisted the Landfill site in Hallen with the erecting of several Abandonment notices for the horses left on their property (This gives the owner 14 days to remove the horses or if this is not done the landowner can dispose of the horses after 14 days). Let's hope by the time you read this our local horse population will have reduced

<u>Fly Tipping</u> – The public footpath/road beside the wood chipping site on the A403 at Pilning has had a load of fly tipping left on it. That is the second load of this type in three weeks. 254959. Well done, Streetcare for dealing with it. <u>South Glos. Enforcement Policy</u> – This has now been approved by the council.

<u>PT/12/4028/O</u> – The former St. Nicholas site has been granted Planning Permission for two houses with the condition that no living rooms can be built on the ground floor.

<u>PT13/0250/F</u> – Planning Permission has been re-submitted for Stables etc. off the A403 on Green Belt land at Northwick. After consultation. I have called this in.

<u>Highways Agency</u> – have clearly pointed the responsibility for maintenance of the M49 footbridge to South Gloucestershire Council. This banana bridge has been reported to South Glos. twice by me. I am waiting for this problem to be addressed.

<u>140697 - Beach Road</u> — The sign at the corner of Station Road and Beach Road adjacent to the flats is leaning back significantly and requires straightening. The Beach Road sign outside 134 Beach Road has been missing for a while. A single post is still there

<u>258255 - Oak Tree</u> – Advice on Oak Tree sought behind Gorse Cover Road. Reply sent to relevant person. <u>Merlin (non-standard) tenants</u> – should have received a personal letter explaining what is happening to their homes. Redevelopment is only taking place in Little Stoke, Chipping Sodbury and Yate. None in Pilning or Severn Beach due to Planning laws.

Station Road Bridge, Pilning - The overhaul is progressing.

**<u>Drain Clearance</u>** on the B4055 – I have seen South Glos. equipment actively checking the drains.

Measles is at an 18 year high.

**<u>Dog Passporting</u>** (chipping) will become compulsory in 2016. I hope it is enforced better than for horses.

Welfare Reform – I attended a South Glos. presentation on the new Welfare System.

Sea wall steps - A request for a banister while the steps are being repaired was received by me. Passed to P&SBPC.

N.B. - Please note when I report these issues I have no control on when they will be actioned by South Glos.
