Our Neighbourhood Plan (NP) will set out the vision for our parish, for the future uses and development types for land within our area. It's a challenging project and an opportunity to decide and plan, with the backing of residents, how Pilning & Severn Beach might be developed in the future and what infrastructure would be needed to support it.

## **Progress update:**

- We're pleased to report that our first grant application was successful. This is a great start and will allow us to make significant progress.
- The funding will be used to; support a survey of residents to be complete by the end of 2021, allow for public presentations and meetings to take place and to engage professional expertise to guide and advise. Our project plan is being amended to reflect timings for spend of the grant over the next 12 months.
- · We have also been successful in applying for free technical support from government organisation Locality who have initially agreed to commence a Housing Needs Assessment. This will identify the types of new housing required in our community.
- At our June meeting, we were joined by a member of SevernNet, who updated us on the transport provision for the people who work in our area, particularly around Western Approaches.
- We plan to have a stand at the Severn Beach Craft Fayre and Family Day on Sat 4 September. Please look out for us, come and say 'hi' and meet some of the team to find out more.
