News:

Severnvale Festival:

A big thank you to everyone who visited our stand on 9th July. It was a great opportunity to engage with residents again to provide information on the way the Neighbourhood Plan is heading and to answer questions.

Call for Sites:

The call for sites closed at the end of July and will allow us to commence the process of evaluation. Professional technical support will be available to the Steering Group to support this work.

Character Assessment Design Codes Study:

We are close to finishing our Character Assessments of the 30 areas identified to cover the whole of the Parish. For the Design Codes Study we have agreed with Locality that they will focus on 6 already developed areas to determine the design codes.

Strategic Infrastructure-led Masterplan:

The Steering Group met with SGC and Atkins to be briefed on their draft Masterplan for Severnside. We were pleased to see that much of the input from us in earlier rounds of consultation has been included. However, we have still submitted a long list of suggested amendments and queries for their consideration.
