Steering Group Secretary:

Call for Sites:

Thank you to all those that submitted sites for development consideration in the Neighbourhood Plan process. We were very pleased with the numbers and level of care in the preparation. The evaluation for suitability has commenced.

Flood Risk:

Flood risk will be a significant consideration in the policies of the Neighbourhood Plan. Following our July meeting, which was attended by SGC, we await their update on how the impact of land raising in new developments affects us and what the benefits of the improved sea defences are for housing development.

Aims and Objectives:

A sub-group has met to agree a set of initial aims and objectives, so far addressing; new housing (including affordable housing levels and accommodation for the elderly), transport and parking, and community facilities.
