

**SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL**  
**(Station Road, Pilning) (Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles, Foot Passengers,  
Pedal Cycles and Equestrians) Order 2022**

Notice is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended intends to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles, foot passengers, pedal cycles and equestrians that length of Station Road which extends from a point 260 metres from its junction with Bank Road in a generally southerly direction for a distance of 70 metres.

This order is required for the following reason: in connection with the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon bridge structure repair works. The order will be operative from 7 July 2022 for a maximum period of eighteen months. The closure however may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only when traffic signs are in position and only for so long as is necessitated by the works which are anticipated to take place on the dates specified in the Schedule to this notice
