7. To consider the following application(s) P25/02322/HS Plot 9000, Land Off Govier Way Western Approach Distribution Park Severn Beach South Gloucestershire BS35 4GG.

Proposal: Application for consent under The Planning (Hazardous Substances) Regulations 2015 for a Natural Gas (Biomethane) refuelling station.

- Strong opposition to the proposed development near Severn Beach due to proximity to residential areas.
- Concerns about hazardous substances and the scale of the silos, which are described as unusually large and inappropriate for the village setting.
- The proposal is seen as planning creep, deviating significantly from the original warehouse consent.
- Uncertainty over whether the site falls under COMAH (Control of Major Accident Hazards) regulations, similar to nearby fertiliser and pharmaceutical sites.
- Suggestion to consult South Gloucestershire Council for clarification.
- Noted risk element beyond standard planning considerations, requiring specialist input.
- Agreement to seek expert advice—potentially from environmental law professionals or industrial safety consultants—to articulate the risks and strengthen the objection.
- Reference to past success in engaging experts (e.g., noise and vibration consultants during sewage issues).
- Mention of potential contacts at Avonmouth or Bristol Port Company with relevant safety expertise.

168/787 Action VB

- Landscape planting to obscure views of the silos from the public realm (though likely ineffective due to silo height).
- Traffic mitigation: request financial contributions for road safety improvements, especially at Govier Way junction.
- Suggestion that the developer could fund a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO).
- Proposal to request an extension for the council response to allow time to consult experts.
