4 Matters arising

<u>918 Bus service funding support letter</u> – this has already been sent to Olveston Parish Clerk due to time constraints.

<u>e-Scooters on A403</u> – working with SevernNet and WECA to get a suitable solution.

<u>Ableton Court</u> – nothing to add this month.

<u>Relocation of Northwick / Aust stone</u> – The Clerk has contacted the ASEA consultant and is waiting a reply. Veterans' group are interested in using some of the stone for their memorial.

Drainage Ditches - agenda item

<u>Bristol Zoo Project</u> – will be coming to give a presentation at the start of the January meeting. With reference to their desire to help with local nature conservation activities.

<u>Conifers at Pilning allotment</u> – work is due to take place early in the New Year. Noted that tree T2 is not in an ideal location but that it is perfectly healthy.

<u>M49 J1</u> – Clarification that work on the junction should begin in Spring 2024 with completion expected Spring 2025.

.1 Bank reconciliation for the previous month see appendix C

To comply with Parish Council Financial Regulation 3. viii the Chairman was presented with the bank reconciliation.

7a Public Participation

<u>Truck stop</u> – a member of the public expressed disappointment that the truck stop was refused but realised that the location was not ideal. The resident was reassured that requests are being made that a section of land just outside the 1957 consent area and near to the M49 J1 is being earmarked for a truck stop. Parish Councillors and the Neighbourhood Plan shared concern that truckers are having to live in unsanitary conditions, without any welfare, due to the set times trucks are allowed to stand at the various warehouses on Western Approach.

<u>Amendment of the Action Plan</u> – The finance committee meeting on 7th December will be reviewing the Action Plan.

Pilning bin relocation – the Clerk stated that this is work in progress.

7b Report from District Councillor Simon Johnson

Questions and comments to District Councillor

<u>A403</u> - Comment was made that it was very disappointing that information was received regarding the recent closures of the A403 came from a third party and not Highways England nor South Glos Council. Poorly signposted the first time round causing residents to be kept awake with HGVs running through the parish all through the night. Second closure better signposted.

<u>Drifting on Western Approach</u> –antisocial driving on Western Approach, as the road is not yet adopted there is little SGC can do to enforce; however, members of the public are encouraged to call 999.

<u>Members Funding</u> – MP asked if members funding could be considered for getting materials for a pump track. Concerns were raised that there would be no one responsible for the safe construction and operation of a pump track.

8 AGENDA ITEMS

.1 To confirm the response regarding 918 bus future funding.

The Clerk confirmed that a letter of support has been sent to the Clerk at Olveston regarding the 918-bus service, with a view to securing funds from WECA for future years.

Action closed

.2 To decide on a response to S Wales X bus route running via Easter Compton & Pilning.

This bus service has run via the parish during periods of motorway road works. The suggestion was made that a request is sent to the Welsh Assembly Govt that, given the numbers from South Wales being bused into Western Approach, there would be a good business case to divert the X service via the parish. An alternative would be to a least reinstate the Aust motorway junction stop. First stage will be to discuss this with SevernNet who are leading the discussion.

Resolved to contact SevernNet with agreement to be involved in the discussion.

Action JE

.3 To decide on a response to A403 bridge failure in the parish.

Feedback given to SJ, given the poor organisation of the first day of the engineering work.

.4 To decide to enquire about the status of the other overbridges in the parish.

As with 8.4 concern is raised at the condition of the other bridges built at the same time as the A403 / M49 bridge.

.5 To decide to get a response from Highways regarding bridge abutment settlement.

Given the difficulty of the A403 / M49 bridge condition the question needs to be asked that repair work is carried out to those bridges in the parish that have settlement issues as these will be more likely to fail given the hammer blow onto the bridge joints.

Resolved to write to SGC Highways and National Highways on agenda items 8.3, 8.4 and 8.5

SGC to be sent a reminder about the outstanding request to repair Northwick Road bridge over the former railway line and Marsh Common Road incline on the Swanmoor side of the Parish. **Resolved to write again.**

Action JE

.6 To receive a report regarding the Coastal path railway crossing at Severn Beach.

This has been raised with the South Glos Cllr responsible for transport, who in turn has raised it with Network Rail. Looking forward to a positive response on this matter. The fact that NR say that the crossing matches their rural crossing criteria misses the point that getting onto the crossing does not give a suitable standard of access.

Resolved to seek an update for the January meeting.

Action PT & JE

.7 To decide on how to better report to SGC, breaches of weight limit restrictions.

Concern raised about overweight vehicles going through the Parish. There does not appear to be a suitable way of reporting this to South Glos Council. SJ commented that Hallen has a similar issue, a survey has been undertaken to check the weight of vehicles through that village. Also, to ask the emerging speed watch team to consider checking for large vehicles coming through the village.

Resolved to ask SGC to organise a vehicle weight survey on Marsh Common Road / Cross Hands Road

Action JE

.8 To decide on a course of action regarding Severn Beach allotment drainage.

The Clerk has been in contact with Severn Internal Drainage Board (LSIDB) and the tractor driver who carries out the work. Access to Severn Beach allotments can now take place.

Questions and comments to NPSG

- <u>Solar Farm at Cattybrook Farm</u>, one third of the site will be in the Parish. The solar farm scheme in planning terms appears to be inefficient use of land as it loses agricultural farmland, when there are warehouse roofs on Severnside that could be used instead to generate electricity. In principle there would be no objection to having a solar farm but its location is cause for concern.
- <u>Community Benefit Agreement</u> regarding the solar farm above the Parish Council has been told that an amount of money would be available for community benefit. The community grant was offered once the planning application had been submitted. The Parish Council at the time used a third-party advisor to negotiate the grant. PT raised concerns that the potential grant money could be to colour the Parish Councils decision for or against the development.
- <u>Communication</u> concerns were raised that communication between nearby landowners and the solar farm developer have not been adequate and neighbours have only found out about the proposals by chance.
- <u>Rookery Lane</u> Use of this and other very narrow roads for the construction and maintenance of the site is not acceptable to a neighbour of the proposed development. Aurora Hedgeway School drop and pick up could very well be disrupted by the additional solar farm traffic.
- <u>Demarcation fencing</u> the proposed fencing for the site is of an industrial scale and not appropriate for an open countryside setting.
- <u>Quality of farmland</u> noted that the piece of farmland in question is liable to flood as the land dips before rising out of the valley.

RE responded that there is a proposed figure of £20,000 a year but the detail of how that is managed is yet to be worked out. Concerns were noted regarding the construction of the site causing additional vehicles along unsuitable roads.

Resolved for the Clerk to write to the Senior Planning Officer SGC regarding the potential conflict of interest in offering grant money in determining the application.

10 PLANNING

.1 Items from the public relating to planning matters.

<u>P23/03069/F and Pilning Station Former Goods Yard</u> – until the pandemic Euroloos were using the land to dispose of human waste. With the intervention of the Environment Agency this practice was stopped but the company continued to wash out the units at the site. Since then, another company has taken over the site and is using it to store cars destined for scrap.

The cars are being taken from the station yard site round to the former Pump house where they are burned out and the metal recovered. Fires take place day and night releasing any amount of noxious material into the air. Enviro Crime dept at South Glos, Environmental protection, Police and the Environment Agency all have ongoing complaints. A joint meeting between the various agencies has been arranged and the results of that meeting are expected soon. Although there is no objection to the planning application as such there are many concerns as to the business taking place at the site.

<u>Cross Hands</u> (SJ) has been contacted by the SGC officer with an update. The item is not yet adequately resolved according to SGC. Despite a successful prosecution, the remaining items were not removed by the end of November. A further enforcement visit is planned.

Bristol & Avon sign - this has been reported to South Glos Enforcement, an officer has been to assess the item.

.5 To decide on professional legal advice – ref Orchard Pools

NP and PT explained they have a meeting with the landowner / developer representative coming up, date to be confirmed. The meeting will be attended by the Clerk to take notes and other Councillors should they wish to attend. Thanks, noted to Cllr Chris Wilmore and Cllr Simon Johnson for enabling the conversation to be started.

11 PARISH EVENTS

<u>Remembrance Sunday</u> – feedback was given to PT that one of the uniformed organisations felt excluded from the event. It was felt that this is not something for the Parish Council to sort out but better communication amongst the uniformed organisations.

Resolved to look at improving road closure awareness for the 2024 Remembrance Parade

<u>Car parking near war memorial</u> – PT noted that consideration should be given to getting South Glos to put a parking order in place to prevent cars being parked at the junction of Cross Hands Road for the Remembrance service.

Resolved not to pursue this item.

12 UPDATES

12.1 Village Halls

12.1.1 Severn Beach Village Hall

Minutes circulated previously.

ND noted that the basketball hoop project was mentioned, the supplier has refunded the money for not being able to supply the requested equipment. ND has been given a free backboard for the inconvenience caused.

Resolved to continue with this action.

12.1.2 Pilning Village Hall

Minutes circulated previously.

A response is expected regarding the insurance issue raised with the committee. Noted that the last set of minutes showed only four bookings for the hall and it is difficult to justify spending residents money on an underused building.

Teen hut graffiti is being attended to, other than that issue the rest of the field looks acceptable. The large Parish Council sign is being fitted with a new piece of marine ply and refitted to the fence.

12.2.1 Severn Beach Allotments

The Clerk is about to send out the invoices for 2024.

Severn Beach allotments tidy for the time of year.

Wood pile an issue, TD is going to undertake some small fires to pick away at the wood. A suggestion was made about using a woodchipper but there is far too much metal contained within the wood.

Plots 10, 13, 14, relet 29, 34 and 38 not really being worked.

12.4 Railway Stations

12.4.1 Pilning Station

OT reported several issues at Pilning Station

- OT wrote an email to MP Jack Lopresti with a view to finding out if any additional funding would be available for Pilning Station now the northern part of HS2 is scrapped. WECA has been allocated £100m for infrastructure projects. Dan Norris (WECA mayor) has been made aware of the potential benefits of reopening Pilning station properly.
- Car park is in an appalling state, this is in part due to the issue mentioned in 10.1 Planning matters from the public.
- Inconsiderate parking by the platform gate has been reported to British Transport Police.
- Service disruption has seen the afternoon train arrive after sunset, there is just enough light to detrain safely with the security light in the compound.
- OT to pass on contact details to the clerk.

OT was thanked for her relentless and ongoing support in keeping Pilning station in the minds of everyone.

Appendix C Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group (NPSG) Report to Parish Council 4th

December 2023 – delivered by Richard Edwards

The NPSG meeting since last PC meeting was on 14th November. Matters discussed and arising since are as follows:

Funding:

Having been given verbal confirmation from Locality of availability of an additional grant of up to ± 10 K for the flood risk consultancy work, we have commenced the process for handing back what we have not spent this year and re-claiming.

Green Belt:

The Green Belt Review Report and Exceptional Circumstances Report which make the case for removal of land from the Green Belt in Pilning have been completed and sent to SGC. We await their reply to that and our request for a meeting to agree the Green Belt approach and to discuss other matters including flood risk and certain site issues.

Flood Risk:

We've received and digested the Product 4 and Product 6 flood risk information requested from the EA. This allowed us to complete the GB Exceptional Circumstances Report and to prepare the first draft of the Parish based Sequential Test. The draft Sequential Test will be presented shortly to SGC for discussion at the aforementioned meeting, with an aim of them setting up a joint meeting with the EA. All this will allow us to determine the exact scope of work required to be carried out by consultants.

Evaluation of Sites:

Some communications continue with landowners and agents.

- We have received an initial site plan for 21/23 Cross Hands Road, Pilning. This shows a proposed scope for 9 4 bedroom detached properties.
- The owner of the land on the corner of Northwick and Bank Road has advised us of his intention to submit an application for an alternative traveller site on Marsh Common Road

SGC's Local Plan:

Reported orally at the last meeting but not in my written note, for the new draft Local Plan, we are pleased to see our NP is recognised, having its own paragraph. Swanmoor Stoke, 3,000 new homes on the edge of the Parish, isn't supported. There are a number of sites around Easter Compton for approximately 450 homes that are supported.

Planning Applications:

No new planning applications were discussed at the meeting.

However, the public consultation for a solar farm development at Cattybrook Farm was raised. Steering Group members attended and made their personal comments at the presentation. For information; around 1/3 of the development would be in our parish, sited on prime grazing land, with access for construction and maintenance through Rookery Lane. Issues known to have been raised included, alternative siting of panels on roofs of industrial buildings, appropriate balance and methods of distribution of annual funds for community use, and suitability of roads.

Pilning & Severn Beach Parish Council Report | Monday 4th December 2023

Key updates for Parish Council colleagues in December 2023;

• The M49 junction project has now achieved planning approval and further support from the South Gloucestershire Council cabinet to progress. Kelvin Packer updated the Severn Net community this week, and is progressing as planned to finalise the scheme, secure the land necessary and deliver the long-awaited project that will support local people and businesses.

• Member Awarded Funding (MAF) is being directed to fund the Pilning & Severn Beach Youth Consultation and support the local Library during this financial year. If Parish Councillors are aware of any other small schemes, I would welcome any input to ensure the funds are fully invested into local schemes that benefit people living here.

• Multiple consultations are available online and seeking input from the local community. A key part of our administration's approach is to consult on the challenging financial landscape in the Local Authority. People may well have seen how other Las across England are struggling financially and we wish to ensure that local residents are aware of the challenge and contribute to our plans to make savings and prioritise key areas of work. Residents should view the SGC website to contribute, most recently on the budget, libraries and A38 cycle developments.

• Support for local resident's this month have focussed on planning issues and aspects related to the two static home parks in the ward. Conversations are ongoing with residents and owners through South Glos Council Officer's who have been very supportive.

• South Glos Council planning enforcement teams have been in contact with the owner of the Cross Hands Pub in the ward, enforcing the clean-up of the site from a recent visit. This will be followed up following local input that the site still remains untidy.

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
