2 Declarations of Interest

3 Minutes of the previous Parish Council Meeting

The minutes of the previous Parish Council Meeting held on the 6th February were unanimously approved as a true record.

<u>Low Level Noise</u> - MP has added the new correspondent to the list of people being affected by the low-level noise. Consideration given to the change in acoustics with new buildings being put up. <u>Non-voting governor</u> – Still no contact from Severn Beach School with the Council even after a reminder from the Clerk.

<u>Library book selection</u> – The Clerk wrote to the head of libraries at South Gloucestershire Council and this has assisted with getting a better selection of books for Severn Beach Community library.

State of A403 at Severnside – The Clerk has written to South Gloucestershire Council. Mark King confirmed there will be a cleaning run "over the forthcoming weeks"

New Passage 20mph restriction – The Parish Council received a petition from residents in New Passage Road strongly requesting the speed limit be reduced to 20mph.

Dear Ward Members,

Fly Tipping - on the night of the 20th two tipper lorries discharged their waste in three gateways including Little Green Lane. Also, in Bilsham Lane. The Network Rail approach to Pilning station also had the same atrocious action.

Vandalism – I am told this occurred on the evening of the 24th in the Gorse Cover Road area. A motorcycle stolen, dwellings have been entered and fire extinguishers stolen. Most of the stolen property has been recovered.

Postage Stamps – from 6th April First Class will cost £1.10 and Second Class 73p.

South Glos. Streetcare – is trialling collecting soft plastic waste in some areas.

Marriage Age – Has now been increased to 18 years old for England and Wales with no exceptions. **No transgender** – persons can be incarcerated in female prisons in the UK the Justice Minister has decided.

Wind Turbine– The largest of its type is being assembled on the A403 next to the gas turbine power stations in Bristol.

Bus Companies - outside London, 130 in all charge only £2 for any single journey until June for Adult tickets.

Hospital Discharge – South Glos. have received a grant for 10 extra Social Workers to be employed at hospitals to assist patient discharges.

Menopause – from 1st April a £20 annual voucher will be available for ladies prescribed HRT. ASEA Flood Defence – The Flood Gates and glass panel barrier has been commissioned at New Passage.

Knives repository – There is a secure box at the entrance of Patchway Police Station to deposit any unwanted knives.

Rail Fares – These will increase by 5.9% in April.

High Seas – the UN has agreed that non-territorial waters some 30% of the oceans will be protected by 2030. This will allow fish etc. to recover in the future.

APPENDIX D Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group

NP SG Report to Parish Council 6th March 2023

SG meeting since last PC meeting: 14th February. Matters discussed and arising since.

Planning Applications:

There were no applications meriting response. It was discussed whether the ToR should be changed so that the NPSG can submit concerns about a planning application directly to Planning, rather than via the PC. The current process takes time and may not reach Planning before the deadline. From discussion with the Clerk after the meeting, it was concluded the SG could do this anyway without a need to amend the ToR.

SEA Scoping Document:

AECOM has received responses from the EA and Natural England to the scoping document. The EA has said they 'strongly advise against promoting new residential development in this area'. This is on the basis of flood zone 3 rather than seeing any proposals for the NP. To-date the Steering Group has not started its own engagement with the EA. This will commence in the near future and we are currently arranging a meeting with SGC to discuss this matter, green belt, and to understand the current position with the Local Plan.

Evaluation of Sites:

Site visits by AECOM took place on 20th and 21st February. We are awaiting the final report from AECOM. However, they have seen the response from the EA to the SEA scoping document, and have now suggested they would deviate from the agreed approach and include a site evaluation based on flood risk. The SG has urged AECOM not to move away from what was agreed between SGC and the Steering Group. We are arranging a meeting with them later this week to remedy the situation. A Teams meeting was held with SGC Transport Planning and their consultant on 1st March to discuss proposals for car parking at land adjacent to SB station.

Neighbourhood Development Plan:

Stuart Miles of Vision Planning has provided us with his recommendations for changes to the vision, objectives and policies. Following a sub-group meeting on 28th February, the document is now going through a major revision and re-structure, which should be completed by the middle of March, to enable display boards to be prepared for the public presentations.

Public Presentations:

The Steering Group has arranged 2 public presentation events on Tues 28th March at Emmaus Church, 6pm to 9pm, and Sat 1st April at Mafeking, 10am to 1pm. A reminder: the main purpose is to consult on sites, objectives and policies. A sub-group meeting was held on 21st February to decide on the material to be prepared.

This is an important stage in the NP process and we sincerely hope that all Parish Councillors can confirm they will be able to attend one of the presentation events. We need to be sure councillors are informed and on board with the proposals.
