## **SCHEDULE**

### REDUNDANCY SCHEME

This Scheme is made by the Church Commissioners this 20th day of June 1972 in pursuance of the Pastoral Measure 1968.

#### Whereas:-

- 1. By an Order of the Church Commissioners dated the 7th day of September 1971 and made pursuant to section 54(1) of the said Measure, the church of Saint Thomas Northwick being a chapel of ease within the parish of Saint Peter Pilning in the diocese of Bristol (hereinafter referred to as "the redundant building") was declared redundant:
- 2. The Advisory Board for Redundant Churches have given a certificate pursuant to proviso (i) to section 49(1) of the said Measure:

Now, therefore, it is hereby provided as follows: -

- 1. The tower together with any other part of the redundant building the retention of which is in the opinion of the Church Commissioners necessary to support the tower (hereinafter together referred to as "the tower") shall be appropriated to use as a monument.
- 2. The remaining part of the redundant building (hereinafter referred to as "the church") shall be demolished and the materials thereof shall be disposed of by the Church Commissioners.
- 3. The contents of the redundant building (not being tombstones, monuments or memorials) shall be disposed of as the Bishop of Bristol shall direct.
- 4. The land annexed or belonging to the redundant building and the land forming the site of the church shall be appropriated to use as a local authority burial ground.
- 5. The Church Commissioners are hereby empowered to give the tower and the said land for such uses as aforesaid.
